Visit of Hodler Monet & Munch exhibition at Fondation Gianadda followed by lunch at Pizzeria d'Octodure - Saturday 1st April

Although these three painters are from different countries and generations, they belong to a period of change and discovery in the Europe of the second half of the 19th and beginning of the 20th century which affected the way they lived and developed as artists. They invented a new kind of painting to capture the movements of water, the subtleties of snow, dazzling sunlight. What this exhibition shows is their ceaseless attempts to grapple with these questions.

At the heart of the museum's programme, the new permanent exhibition places visitors at the core of the message, inviting them to think about the body, their environment and their social circle. Virtual and sensory experiments aim to make visitors aware of the complexity of food across the world and through the ages.
