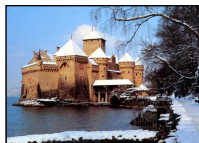

You will be able to watch stone cutters at work, toiling away to the rhythmic hammering at the forge, setting the pace for the stories, songs and dances of yesteryear.

Adults and children aged 6 years and over CHF 15, Children under 6 years CHF 6. Senior citizens and students CHF 13.

Persons with reduced mobility go free as not all events might be accessible.

Lunch will be served in the magnificent Chateau Hall at a cost of CHF 16, medieval 'plat du jour' style - desserts and drinks extra. No bookings are taken for lunch, but arriving early is recommended.
