A visit to the restaurant Les 3 Sifflets has become a fixture in our schedule. Although they offer some traditional Swiss dishes such as croûte au fromage or désossée de perches, and a few inspired by French brasserie cuisine, we keep going back for the fondue, whether moitié-moitié, tomato or other – each caquelon borne in to the accompaniment of military music and the Swiss flag.



Shrove Tuesday pancakes at Fellowship Centre of Scots Kirk Tuesday 28th February - 11h30 am



Pancake Day, or Shrove Tuesday, is the traditional feast day before the start of Lent on Ash Wednesday. Lent - the 40 days leading up to Easter - was traditionally a time of fasting and on Shrove Tuesday Anglo-Saxon Christians went to confession and were "shriven" (absolved from their sins). A bell would be rung to call people to confession. This came to be called the "Pancake Bell" and is still rung today. Shrove Tuesday was the last opportunity to use up

eggs and fats before the Lenten fast and pancakes were the perfect way of using these ingredients.

The pancake has a long history and featured in cookery books as far back as 1439. The tradition of tossing or flipping them is almost as old: "And every man and maide doe take their turne, And tosse their Pancakes up for feare they burne." (Pasquil's Palin, 1619). We probably won't be tossing them but will certainly be enjoying them with a variety of toppings to suit everyone!

Sunday 26th March - 10.30 am

Nestlé opened the museum "nest" in Vevey to celebrate its 150-year



anniversary. The discovery centre for children and adults spans more than 3000 square metres at the exact location where Henri Nestlé first developed his baby food in 1866. During a spectacular multimedia trip, visitors learn about the company's 150-year history and about products, such as Cailler chocolate, Maggi seasoning and Thomy mayonnaise a trip that starts at the beginning and leads on to the future.

The exhibition also addresses other issues, e.g. the handling of resources or the relationship between water and production.

A large, publicly accessible outdoor plaza offers room to relax or have a bite to eat. A mini-factory for the kids, a café, a souvenir shop, and the villa where Henri Nestlé used to have his office, are also part of the discovery centre.

Price (includes audioguides in English): brunch & visit adults : CHF 45.-, seniors & students 43.-, children 6-18 25.-, 0-6 free.

Buy your entry ticket to nest and gain 40% off your ticket to visit the Alimentarium or the Maison Cailler.
