**The English theatre group ADG Europe presents**  
**“The Tempest” by William Shakespeare at Château de Chillon**  
21 Avenue de Chillon, 1820 Veytaux - **Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> June**  
7.30 pm to 10 pm - Adults CHF 40/students & children CHF 25

«Shakespeare's last great masterpiece - and the most magical story ever written - centres on a magician, Prospero, exiled on a remote island with his daughter by his scheming brother. His old enemies are washed ashore in a storm (or tempest) that he conjures from the skies. Prospero has to choose between revenge and forgiveness. But his plans are undermined by the beast he civilised and then enslaved: Caliban. As Caliban mounts a murderous rebellion and Prospero's daughter falls in love with the son of her father's enemy, the play reaches a thrilling climax.»

This outdoor production is part of ADG's Castle Tour 2016 and will take place come rain, come shine, so be prepared!

## **Lunch and visit of newly-opened Chaplin's World**

(rte de Fenil 2-5, 1804 Corsier-sur-Vevey)

at the Manoir de Ban, Charlie Chaplin's home for 25 years until his death in 1977

**Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> June** - Price adults CHF 23/children 6-15 CHF 17

'A new building has been built nearby as a mock-up of a Hollywood studio focusing on Chaplin's movie work, which began in 1914.

Walking through the 16-metre-high studio, fans can learn about Chaplin's early humble beginnings in London and his meteoric rise to become one of the biggest names in the film industry at only 26.

Thanks to recreated sets and embedded film screens, visitors can experience what it was like to walk down "Easy Street" or be in a cabin teetering on the edge of a cliff, like in "The Gold Rush." Elsewhere, you can sit in the barber's chair from "The Great Dictator" or look in at the restaurant where he ate in "The Immigrant".

The studio is completed with endless clips from his films, interactive exhibits and multimedia installations, and a 150-seat cinema.

Chaplin's World also features 30 wax figures created by the Grévin wax museum in Paris. These include lifelike models of Chaplin, his wife Oona, actors and actresses from his films, and friends like Albert Einstein, as well as artists inspired by his work such as Michael Jackson, Woody Allen and Federico Fellini.'
