



Saillon – the next chapter?

Our recent outing to the village of Saillon whets the appetite for a wider exploration of this region.

The story of Joseph-Samuel Farinet, outlaw and counterfeiter of money which he distributed to the poor, and thus beloved of the population, inevitably takes centre stage – his name has inspired not only films and poetry but also a 'celebrity' vineyard and, since last year, an official currency, called the farinet, designed to support the local economy.

We learned more of this history at the village's counterfeit museum, and enjoyed a relaxed lunch on the terrace of the Café de la Poste.

Next time we must go further than the church and its medieval gardens, and aim for La Passerelle à Farinet, a slender footbridge across the gorge at the foot of which the fleeing Farinet met his death. Then we shall have earned a dip in the thermal baths.
