As a tribute to Jacqueline Picasso, who passed away 30 years ago on October 15th 1986, The Pierre Gianadda Foundation presents an extraordinary selection of paintings, engravings, ceramics and sculptures, casting a new perspective on Picasso’s late work. Fascinating and enlightening, the last twenty years of Picasso’s career are an anthem dedicated to love, life and creation.

The exhibition shows how Jacqueline, whom he met for the first time in 1952 and married in 1961, was permanently present in his work. His last muse and wife, she was his only model during all the years she stood by his side.

Trinity House was founded by Royal Charter of King Henry VIII in 1513 to maintain lighthouses and navigational aids for the newly formed Royal Navy. To-day, its flagship ‘Patricia’ carries passengers as she completes her vital work around the coasts of England, Wales and the Channel Islands.

The experience of being on board allows her guests to view her duties of maintaining navigational buoys, attending to and refuelling offshore lightships and on occasions, dealing with emergencies at sea. There is an ‘Open Bridge’ policy where passengers are invited to experience the knowledge of the officers and crew and learn something of navigation at sea.

A voyage on board ‘Patricia’ is a unique experience with very comfortable cabin accommodation and excellent food. A most fascinating, relaxing and enjoyable week at sea can be guaranteed. The presentation will include pictures of the passenger areas, the crew at work as well as coastal views.
