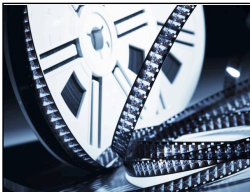
Dinner at 8 pm - Karaoke from 9.30/10 pm

The play follows her hired hand, Francis, who inadvertently accepts work from a second master, Stanley Stubbers, and who must keep his two masters apart to avoid discovery in this wittily written and energetic script filled with a host of memorable characters and electrifying set-pieces.
