




**Musée de la Confrérie des Vignerons, Rue du Château 2,
1800 Vevey
Sunday 20th October**

The Brotherhood of Winegrowers, whose origins are as mysterious as they are old, has established its headquarters on the first floor of this 16th century house, which it owns. The first written traces proving the existence of the Brotherhood go back to the year 1647, but several clues give rise to the supposition that it has existed since the Middle Ages. Its main purpose is to protect the interests of vineyards and vine growers, particularly in the UNESCO-listed Lavaux wine region. The current exhibition gives an updated history of the Fête des Vignerons, as well as showing costumes, engravings and many other objects connected with past festivals, plus film excerpts from the beginning of the 20th century. Entry is free. In the same building you can also visit the Vevey History Museum.

**Visit of Domaine de la Doges, la Tour-de-Peilz - Free guided tour in French
Saturday 26th October**

The Domaine de la Doges in La Tour-de-Peilz was bequeathed in 1997 to the Swiss heritage society (and its vineyards to the Brotherhood of Winegrowers) with the stipulation that this 17th century mansion, in its verdant setting, and with a panoramic view of the lake, should continue to stand as witness of a bourgeois home over the past centuries.

It is with this in mind that the mansion, with its furnishings and objects belonging to the daily life of well-to-do Vaudois families of the 18th, 19th and 20th centuries, has been passed on. Many families have shaped the history and the face of La Doges. Their precious family archives shed light on their comfortable, even sumptuous way of life, their mentality and the customs of their time.

On a visit to the Warrior Games in the USA in 2013, HRH Prince Harry, The Duke of Sussex, saw how the power of sport can help physically, psychologically and socially ex-

Armed Services personnel suffering from injuries and illness. Inspired by his visit, he started the Invictus (meaning “Unconquered”) Games, the first of which took place in London in 2014. The 5th Games will be in The Netherlands in 2020.

As 2019 marks the 80th Anniversary of the start the Second World War and the 75th Anniversary of the D-Day Landings in Normandy to liberate Western Europe from Nazi Germany’s occupation, it was decided, with the support of British associations in Switzerland, including the BRA, that a concert should be held to mark the anniversaries and to raise funds for the Invictus Games Foundation.

The concert will feature the Brass Band Arquebuse, Switzerland’s leading ensemble in the brass band style, the Pipes and Drums Band of Geneva, a massed choir and soloists. The hall seats nearly 1000 people and the audience will include diplomatic representatives of the 12 countries that were involved in the D-Day Landings in June 1944, as well as from the Federal Republic of Germany and Russia, formerly the Soviet Union.
