- ★ **Till 18th October - 14th Triennial of contemporary sculpture in the open air at Parc de Szilassy, Bex - open daily from 10h to 19h.**

Why not take a trip down to Bex and visit the Bex&Arts Sculpture Triennial, still on till 18th October?

Since the triennial's creation in 1981 it has established itself as an important artistic institution among the many open-air shows presented in Switzerland. It offers Swiss artists and those working in Switzerland an opportunity to show their works in a historical setting: the park, an English landscape garden, belonging to the former Szilassy estate, was created high above the town of Bex and the Rhône valley in 1835 and left to the Canton of Vaud in 1969. The 2020 triennial brings together sculptors from across Switzerland and the world around a main theme: industry.

The park covers an area of 7.4 hectares, its paths leading to a series of sculptures and installations, and vantage points inviting you to contemplate the beautiful natural surroundings.

Address: Bex&Arts, rue du Signal, 1880 Bex; 5-minute walk from Place du Marché
Open daily from 10h to 19h till 18th October; buvette with snacks open from 11h30
Access to the exhibition – cash payment only: Adults CHF 16, AVS & other reductions CHF 12, Children from 7 to 13 CHF 5, under 6 free.
